

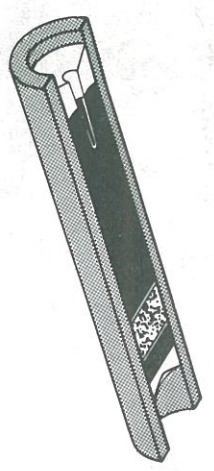

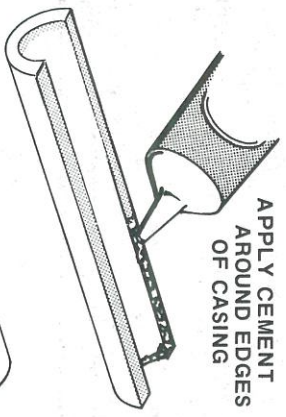

### Display Model Rocket

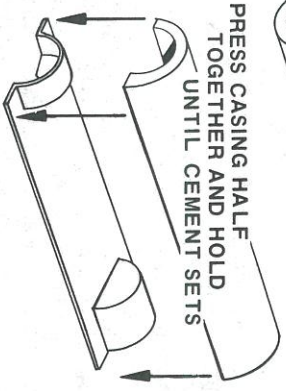
**11** Apply plastic model cement to the engine casing half over the area shown in the illustration. Apply enough cement to cover the surface in these areas, but do not stop it on. Place the molded plastic engine piece face down on a flat surface. Press down the casing half in place and hold it until the cement sets.

**PRESS CASING HALF TOGETHER AND HOLD UNTIL CEMENT SETS**

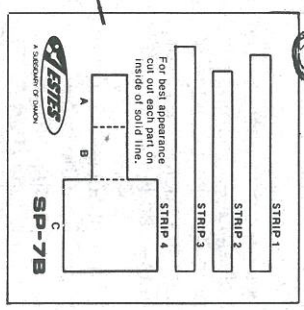
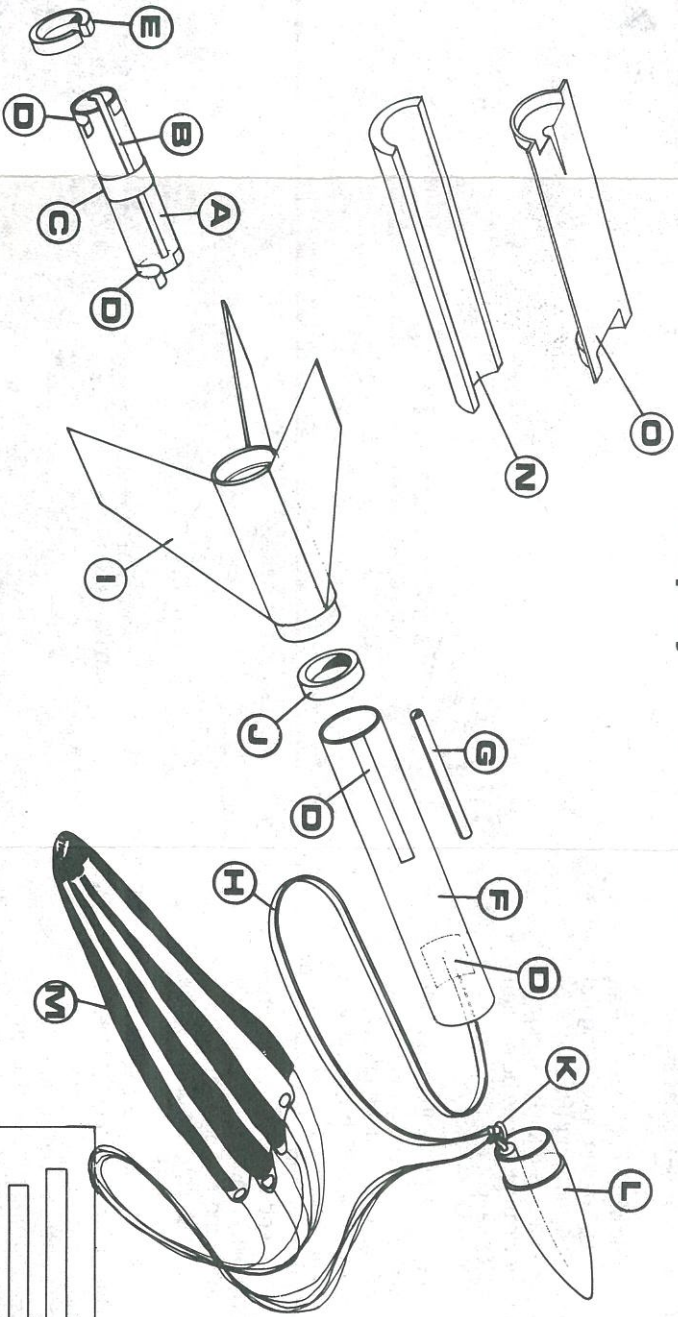
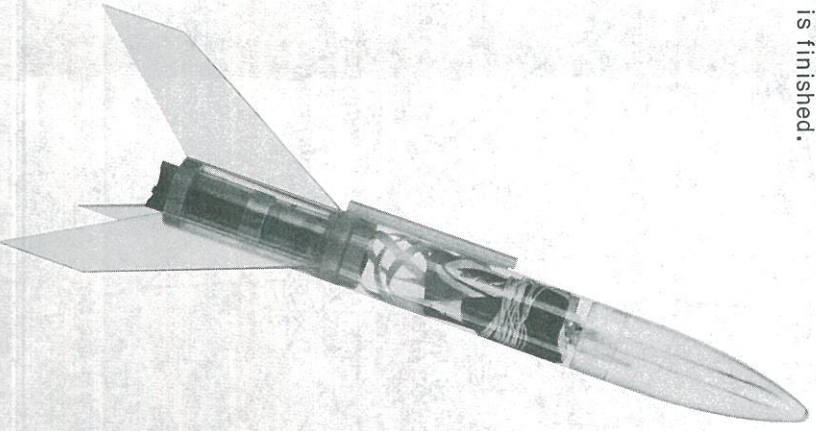


**PLASTIC FROM CASING**

**12** After the cement on the engine cutaway assembly has completely dried, trim the extra plastic from around the edges of the tube half. Use a very sharp knife and work carefully to avoid cutting the tube. Paint the plastic using enamel paint of the type which is especially

- BLACK
- BROWN
- ORANGE

formulated for use on styrene plastics (Testor's Pla, Pactra, Namel, etc.). One suitable paint pattern is shown above. After the paint is dry, slip the cutaway engine into the model's engine mount. Your Astron Phantom is finished.
